	Northline <i>Abundant sweet berries in June. Ht 3m Sp 2.15m</i>	1 2
	Regent <i>Delicious berries in June. Great for jams and pies. Ht 1.8m Sp 1.8m</i>	2
	Smokey <i>Large, fleshy, sweet berries, heavy producer Ht 4m Sp 4m</i>	1 2
	Thiessen <i>Small plants with abundant medium berries; good flavour Ht 2m Sp 1.5m</i>	1 2

<i>Lyeuim barbarum</i>	Goji Berry (Wolf Berry) <i>Tangy red fruit high in antioxidants; needs well drained soil.</i>	1

	Collet <i>Fruit is medium red; flesh is white, firm, crisp. Excellent as sauce or pie. Resistant to fire blight</i>	7	
Malus x 4 varieties	Combination <i>Different varieties of apple grafted on one tree</i>	7	grafted
	Goodland <i>Fruit creamy-green, washed red; good eating and cooking apple, keeps well</i>	7	
	Hardi-Mac <i>Medium apple with bright red fruit that is crispy and juicy. This is a selection from the original McIntosh Apple</i>	7	
	Heaps <i>Large apple, skin is yellow with red striped. Very good eating. Good keeper.</i>	7	
	Honey Crisp <i>A large red apple. Very crisp and sweet; great for eating off the tree. Ripens late September</i>	7	
	Norland <i>A dwarf type hybrid apple. Fruit skin greenish yellow, striped dark red; flesh cream colour tinged green; good for eating or cooking; stores well</i>	7	
	Parkland <i>Hardy upright spreading tree; fruit red; flesh creamy white tinged green, ripens in August; stores well</i>	7	
	Prairie Magic <i>Produces medium-large size fruit in mid-September and is crisp and delicious</i>	7	
	Red Sparkle <i>Medium size apple with nutty-fruity taste; ripens in September; good for cooking and eating</i>	7	
	September Ruby <i>An excellent red apple, sweet and crisp</i>	7	
	Westland <i>Tree has pendulous habit. Large red striped apple; good quality, ripens in August</i>	7

	Carmine Jewel <i>Tart red cherries. Showy white flowers in spring and an upright rounded habit. Ht 2.4m Sp 1.8m</i>	7	
Prunus x kerrasis	Crimson Passion <i>University of Saskatchewan introduction; bright red sweet cherries; high yielding; self-pollinating</i>	7	
	Juliet <i>Fruit is dark red with high sugar content; self-pollinating; excellent for eating fresh</i>	2	
	Romeo <i>Self-pollinating; good for processing; great for fresh eating</i>	7	
	Valentine <i>Medium red fruit; good for processing</i>	7	
Prunus tomentosa	Nanking Cherry <i>A hardy sweet cherry. Flowers are white on pink. A great pollinator for all plum varieties</i>	2	

PLUMS

Prunus x	Bounty <i>Dark red, egg shaped small fruit with orange-yellow flesh; good for preserves</i>	7
	Brookgold <i>Golden yellow plum; fruit is freestone and very sweet; a good eating variety</i>	7

Brookred 7
Medium red plum; very good for eating and cooking

Opata 7
Early plum with yellow fruit. Excellent producer and great pollinator

Pembina 7
Early plum; fruit is red in colour, skin medium thick; flesh is yellow and juicy; sweet flavor, good dessert quality

Tecumseh 7
*Medium deep purple-blue fruit. Good for fresh eating or jams and jellies. Ripens in September. Requires a pollinator.
Ht 4.5m Sp 2.5m*

Mount Royal 5
*Loads of tasty blue prune-plums in late summer. Good for baking. Needs pollinator.
Ht 4m Sp 2.5m* 10

Combination 10
*Multiple varieties of plum budded on one tree. Pollination takes between varieties.
Ht 4.5m Sp 4.5m*

PEARS

Pyrus x **Early Golden** 7
Improved Ure; large yellow fruit, sweet and juicy

Golden Spice 10
Very hardy vigorous grower; profusion of small fruits

Ure 7
Large fruit good for eating fresh or canning

Combination 7
Multiple varieties of pear budded on one tree. Pollination take place between the varieties. 10

RHUBARB

Rheum **Canada Red** 1
Bright red stalk. Excellent for pies, jelly or wine

RASPBERRY

Rubus idaeus **Boyne** 1
An excellent Raspberry with large dark red fruit in early July 2

Double Delight 1
Produces fruit on new growth from August to freeze-up. Excellent flavor 2

Fall Gold 1
Yellow-gold sweet fruit; excellent for eating fresh, preserves, canning 2

Heritage 1
This hardy raspberry has medium-large, sweet, red fruit 2

FRUITING CURRANTS

Ribes hinnomaki **Pixwell Red Gooseberry** 2
Large juicy red fruit, great for jam and pies

Hinnonmaki Yellow 2
Large yellow golden fruit with sweet flesh and tangy skin. Exceptional yield. Very thorny. Ht 1.2m Sp 1.5m

Hinnonmaki Red 2
Tart skin covers these sweet ruby berries. High yield. Ht 1.2m Sp 1.2m

Ribes nigrum **Consort** 2
Medium sized shrub. Tart black berries in summer. Excellent for jams. Ht 1.2m Sp .9m

Wellington 2
Large black berries, richly flavored

Ribes triste **Red Lake Currant** 2
Large red berries in clusters. Great for jams and jellies

BLUEBERRIES

Vaccinium **Chippewa** N/A
Compact habit; huge crops of large, sweet light blue fruit.

Northblue 2
Very hardy hybrid blueberry. Produces bumper crops of tasty, sweet blue fruit mid summer. Ht .6m Sp .9m

North Country 2
Early to mid-season; plants larger and more productive than North Sky, fruit 1/2" in diameter with attractive sky blue colour; flavor sweet and mild

Northland 2
*Hardest high bush blueberry. Sweet dark blue fruit in early summer.
 Ht 1.2m Sp .9m*

North Sky 2
Dwarf bush and dark green foliage; mid season fruit medium size and good flavor

Pink Popcorn 2
*Medium sized cream to pink berries have true blueberry flavour and aroma.
 Ht 1.25m Sp 1.25m*

Polaris 2
Upright spreading habit; tangy sweet light blue fruit

GRAPE VINE

Vitis **Beta** 1
Extremely vigorous vine; produces large clusters of red/purple fruit. Good eating as juice or jelly

Combination 5
Multiple varieties budded on stem.

Valiant 1
Vine with hardy, vigorous purple-blue grapes. Needs sunny location

Minnesota N/A
Reddish purple grapes. Grow this hardy vine in a sunny location
